

whatever you need. Once the floor is clean and rinsed well with clean plain water allow the floor to thoroughly dry keeping foot traffic off it. Once dried apply sealer to a clean White lint free cloth and wipe over the entire floor, making sure to cover every part including the grout. Do not have the floor "wet" with sealer, if too much is on the tiles wipe off excess with a dry clean White cloth.

As always when using chemicals a few things to take into account:-

Always read the manufacturer's instructions on the bottles first, noting safety precautions.

Wear rubber gloves as these chemicals can irritate and inflame skin, wear old clothes

Keep children and pets out of the way while you carry out this work

Always test a small area somewhere unobtrusive to make sure there are no adverse reactions prior to continuing

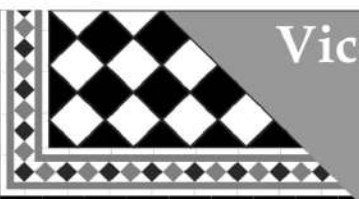
